- Performs accurate mechanical, physical and visual inspection of raw materials, components and assemblies to meet specification requirements, notifies the Quality Manager of findings.
- Read and interpret specifications
- Ability to record and maintain records of findings during inspection
- Perform material kit audits to insure accuracy and integrity of the kitting process
- Perform product identification and traceability activities, as required
- Comply with all quality, safety, and work rules and regulations
